<b>Teaching methodologies (including assessment)</b> <small>[Specify the types of assessment and the weights and evaluation criteria]</small>	<p><b>1 - Teaching methodologies</b></p> <p>The methodology to be followed in this course takes into account the defined objectives and the heterogeneity of students with regard to computer knowledge. Classes will have a theoretical/practical nature. However, due to the specificity of the discipline, the practical component will predominate. So the activities will be guided through a script and developed individually, or if this is not possible in groups of two or three elements.</p> <p>The work proposals will always seek to take into account the type of tasks that students will develop in their future profession, such as: image processing, text digitization, pagination of a newspaper, construction of a poster, etc.</p>
