<p>Teaching methodologies (including assessment)</p> <p>[Specify the types of assessment and the weights and evaluation criteria]</p>	<p>1 - Teaching methodologies</p> <p>The methodology used goes through an initial phase by asking students, in groups of 3 or 4 elements, to choose project themes having as a starting point the identification of a problem that can be solved, with instruments or tools either in the area of journalism , or in the area of organizational communication. Depending on the chosen area, which must be linked to the branch of the course in which they are inserted, they will be guided by each of the UC professors. Depending on their nature, the working groups may also be co-supervised by a professor in the area of information technologies. Once the project themes are approved and the respective supervisor is designated by the course management, the work groups develop the projects autonomously under the guidance of the teachers.</p> <p>2 - Period assessment</p> <p>The evaluation assumes a continuous character, as the supervisor follows the group in the elaboration of the project.</p> <p>In a final phase, the work groups will be evaluated in a public session of oral presentation of the projects and this presentation will take place in the presence of a jury, which will include the supervisor and other teachers proposed by the course management. The course management may send an invitation to a teacher external to the educational institution.</p> <p>With a maximum duration of 20 minutes, students present their work, being later subjected to a critical appraisal and any doubts or questions by the jury.</p> <p>For the respective interventions, it is expected that the jury will also enjoy a period of approximately 20 minutes, including question/answer by the group.</p> <p>The working groups must prepare a written report in which the communication problem is presented, the justification theory for it and the proposed solution for its resolution, as well as the development and procedures carried out for the pursuit of practical work. The written report must be completed and delivered to the supervising professor up to 10 days before the public presentation, preferably in digital format.</p> <p>The evaluation of each group will take into account the written report, the oral presentation, the opinion of the invited jury and the opinion of the respective supervisor, resulting in a classification end of 0 to 20 values.</p> <p>The work will be evaluated according to the following parameters: Work monitoring - 20% Report - 40% Oral presentation - 40%</p> <p>Teachers also safeguard the right not to allow the work to be presented publicly, if the supervisor considers that it does not meet the minimum conditions for such</p> <p>3 - Examination assesement</p> <p>It is not possible to take an exam in this UC.</p>
