Teaching methodologies (including assessment) [Specify the types of assessment and the weights and evaluation criteria]	 1 - Teaching methodologies Practical sessions with a particular focus on language reception and production that consolidate comprehension skills and oral and written expression in Portuguese. Group work is privileged. Sessions of theoretical-practical nature for systematization and deepening of contents. Tutorial sessions for individualized follow-up of the students' coursework. 2 - Period assessment As this is a curricular unit of a predominantly practical nature, the assessment based on frequency will take into account attendance, participation in classroom activities and a set of written assignments and/ or oral tasks. 										





	 The final classification will be obtained by weighing these different elements, using the following formula: 90% tasks/assignments requested (maximum of 6, 15% each, on average) + 10% attendance and participation. Failure to complete one of the assessment products mentioned above makes it impossible to obtain a final classification by frequency. According to the Regulation of Mandatory Minimum Frequency, students must attend at least 90% of the practical and theoretical-practical hours of the curricular unit.
	3 - Examination assessement
	Any student may request the assessment in the examination periods provided for in the regulations that apply to their status. Passing an exam requires obtaining a minimum grade of 10 (on a scale of 0 to 20). In exams for grade improvement, the highest classification obtained by the student will prevail.
