And that they also come to master the techniques inherent to communication in the form of written text, whatever the means of communication in question. With the Journalism Workshop it is intended that the trainees assimilate the essential practical bases for their integration in a newsroom, being aware of what are, on the one hand, the current market needs, and on the other, the values of social responsibility and ethics inherent to the exercise of journalistic activity. After attending this course, trainees should be able to produce content for journalistic publications, develop activities related to the transmission of journalistic content, and know the most common journalistic genres news, reportage, interview, profile and comment, as well as the techniques of titration. Students must also develop some ability to expose and defend their ideas, as well as adopt an active attitude in the production of works. In other words, it is important to develop some capacity for innovation and creativity in practical situations.
